Daybreak Distinguished Dolphin Second Grade Goals

All children will need to complete a minimum of 15 of the following 20 goals to receive the Daybreak Dolphin Pride Award. Goals will be passed off throughout the year. Watch for monthly goals in the newsletter.

- Memorize and be able to write your full name, address, phone number, and birth date.
- Handwriting: Pass off all upper and lower case manuscript letters using the correct lines. (Zaner Bloser Manuscript)
- Participate in REFLECTIONS.
- Do 15 sit-ups.
- Demonstrate skills for jumping rope, and be able to skip 10 paces.
- Write 10 sentences using your spelling words (sight words).
- Do 5 good deeds and write about them.
- Write a book report and present it to the class.
- Make a pre-approved product that represents a favorite book.
- Writing: Write 3 original stories. Present one to the class.
- Count by 2's, 5's and 10's to 100, and 25's to 100.
- Recognize and count coin combinations to \$1.00
- Read 200 second grade sight words in 6 minutes.
- Run the grass course at school 2 times.
- Research and write a report from an approved topic.
- Reading: 50 hours of reading at home. (3,000 minutes)
- Show proficiency in regrouping using addition.
- Earn 100% on 12 spelling tests.
- Memorize addition and subtraction facts through 20.
- Achieve at least 90% attendance.
