About Our School

East Midvale Elementary, which opened in 1966 is a diverse, Title One school located in Midvale, Utah. It serves 617 students from kindergarten through sixth grade. All teachers are "Highly Qualified" with an exceptional ability to teach. A schoolwide discipline program, "Think Time," encourages students to take responsibility for their behavior and make appropriate changes.

Students are encouraged to learn self-discipline through a "Soaring Eagle" program that rewards academic and social excellence. East Midvale has an active PTA and School Community Council that provide parents many opportunities to be involved in school. School volunteers are valued and encouraged to assist with school programs and activities.

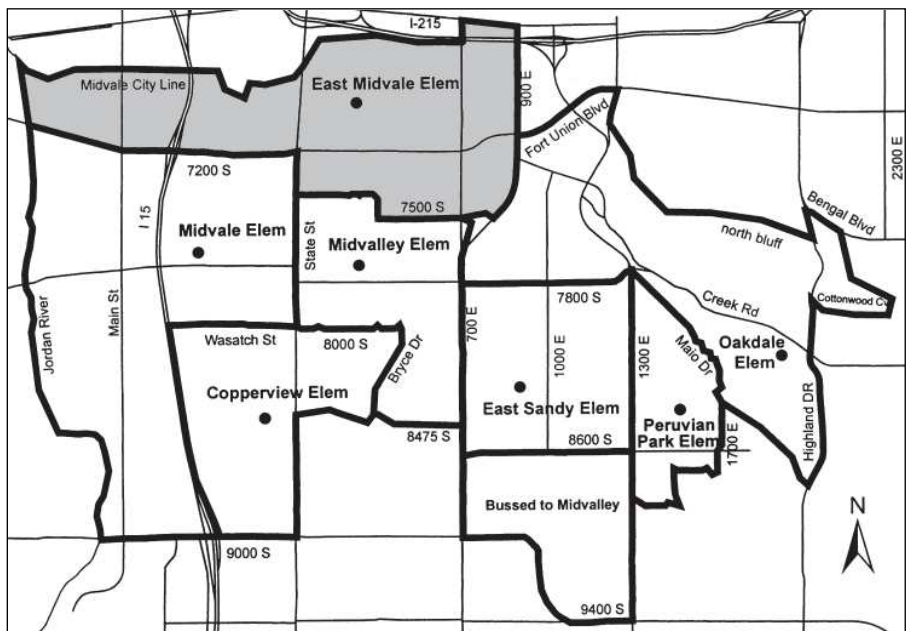

School Boundaries

Begin at the Jordan River and the Midvale City Line (approx. 6800 S.); east along the Midvale City Line (south side) to State St.; northeast from State St. along the Midvale City Line to 6600 S.; east along 6600 S. (south side) to 700 E.; north along 700 E. (east side) to the North District Boundary (6600 S.); east along 6600 S. (south side) to 900 E.; south on 900 E. (west side) to 7500 S. (Greenwood Ave.) and 700 E.; west along 7500 S. (Greenwood Ave.) (north side) to 300 E.; north along 300 E. (both sides to Midvalley) to 7390 S.; west along 7390 S. (both sides to Midvalley) to State St.; north along State St. (east side) to 7200 S.; west along 7200 S. (north side) to the Jordan River, north along the Jordan River (east side) to the Midvale City Line.
