Meeting called to order.

One item of business that needs to be approved so it can be sent to the District offices and the state: Safe Walking Routes & Parking Lot Guidelines and Procedures (Student Neighborhood Access Program).

Kristy and Nancy presented the updated Safe Walking Routes and the Parking Lot Guidelines/Procedures. Members were giving the opportunity to review these, ask questions, and voice any concerns to be presented to the school district and/or city of West Jordan.

Jeri Lynn motioned to accept these plans. It was seconded, and all voted in favor of the routes and procedures.

Concerns:

1. No sidewalks for the children on much of the east side of 3200 West.
2. Students, from the neighborhood to the north of Oquirrh living within Westland's boundaries but attending Oquirrh on permit, crossing at 3200 West and 7000 South on the west side of the intersection with no crossing guards.

This information will be sent home in two separate packets (one for the safe walking routes and one for the parking lot procedures) in the "first day" packets for the 2009-2010 school year.

Safe walking route info and parking lot procedures will also be available on Oquirrh's Web site (Kathy and/or Dan).

Safe walking route info will be distributed at Oquirrh's Kindergarten Orientation later this month.

Thank you to Kristy Whiteside for putting this information together for the school.

Nancy asked members of this group to help gather information for the Title I school-wide assessment by asking our neighbors to participate in a Parent Focus Group interview. A questionnaire was given to us to go through with our neighbors. Get this info back to Nancy ASAP.
